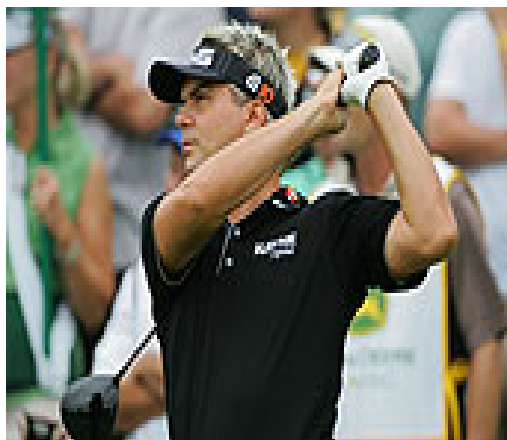
One of the most charismatic players on the PGA TOUR is the handsome and articulate Daniel Chopra. Dan began the 2008 season winning the prestigious Mercedes-Benz Championship in a thrilling playoff duel against Steve Stricker. This win marked the second time Dan had won in his last three tournaments on the PGA TOUR, having also been victorious at the Ginn sur Mer Classic in October, 2007.

Success is not new to Dan who is truly an international player with roots both in his native Sweden, and in India where he was raised. In fact, in 1995 he was the Rookie of the Year on the Asian Tour. In 2004, Dan accomplished a feat that has not been replicated on Tour, posting two wins from only two starts. In 2006, **Dan became the first player in professional golf history to post a score of 30-under par on a professional tournament played on a par-72 golf course**, accomplishing the feat at the Henrico County Open on the PGA TOUR's Nationwide Tour. Additionally, **Dan has posted a total of 13 international victories** during his career. Emphasizing his international flair, in 1995 Dan became the first person to hit a golf ball off the Great Wall of China!

Dan's professional accomplishments come as no surprise when you consider his amateur career. His array of victories include the All India World Junior Championship (1988, 89 and 91), the 1991 Doug Sanders World Junior, and the U.K. Golf Foundation Championship.

Since joining the PGA TOUR in 2004 Dan has enjoyed new accomplishments each year. He won twice on the Nationwide Tour in 2004. Solid play in 2005 resulted in his securing his TOUR card for 2006, when he finished in the Top 10 six times and ended the season Number 54 on the Money List. Also, that year **Dan was the Number ONE Putter on the PGA TOUR**.

Dan has that "X" Factor – his personality, look and genuine charm make him not only a favorite among his PGA Tour peers, but spectators and Pro-AM partners all over the world!
